Information about Gift Aid

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Why Gift Aid?

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, we get an extra 28 pence from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation go further. This means that £100 can be turned into £128.

Imagine what a difference that could make - and it does not cost you a thing.

Benefits to higher-rate taxpayers:

If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can reclaim tax relief on your gross donation at 18% (i.e. the difference between the higher rate of tax at 40% and the basic rate at 22%).

For example, if you give £100 we can reclaim an extra £28.21 for the charity and you can reclaim another £23.08. As a result, a £100 gift worth £128.21 to the charity only costs you £76.92.

So if you want your donation to go further, please Gift Aid it. Just complete this form, read and sign the declaration below.

Notes:

1. You can cancel the Gift Aid Declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
2. Please notify the charity if you change your name or address.
